It has been a pleasure to represent Burnside at Stormont as your UUP MLA, since I replaced David Burnside in June 2009. I know there are many matters ongoing and I will keep pushing on your behalf on any matters raised with me.

Bus Shelters - I, with my councillor colleagues Jim Bingham and Vera McWilliam, will keep pushing for a second bus shelter up at the Island. If any damage occurs to the present bus shelter I will again push for its repair, but please keep me informed.

Derelict buildings - We have worked with the owner, the PSNI and the council to ensure that derelicts are safe and are not misused.

Roads - We have constantly liaised with Roads Service over potholes and recently over the road closure where the culverts were collapsing. They promised to be as quick as they could.

The Cogry Woodland walk/lighting - With my colleagues we are pushing for improved lighting on the woodland walk as well as at the Cogry bridge and also around the children's park.

Youth matters - It is essential that we work with young people and when it becomes necessary with the PSNI to the benefit of the whole community. Misuse of the woodland walk and derelict buildings and other more serious matters have been, and will be, tackled as raised with me.

Youth park/Army cadets - We are helping to promote an Army cadet group and a youth area to be created near the children's park.

Cleaning/mowing/dog bins - We have raised the need to coordinate the mowing and clearing of the area with the council/Roads Service and Housing Executive to try to ensure that Burnside is well looked after.

Local Residents Group - It has been a pleasure to work with the local residents group and to help in keeping Burnside the special place it is. I look forward to carrying on doing so.
