It has been a great pleasure representing Crumlin as an MLA at Stormont over the past 21 months. I have worked with Alderman Mervyn Rea and Councillor Paul Michael over many issues in the Crumlin area, as well as all other MLAs and Councillors.

**Town centre** - We have continually pushed in council and the Assembly for the refurbishment of the town centre which is now happening. I am committed to working with the Crumlin Improvement Association and Crumlin Together to help improve the centre of town, concentrating on trees/shrubs/flower baskets, pavements, lighting, derelict buildings and on the town's Masterplan. We need to praise the two community groups and encourage as many as possible to join and work with them.

**Roads** - It is excellent to see the Mill Road being resurfaced after much lobbying. There are many more areas to concentrate on and I ask all of you to keep us posted as to the needs.

**Transport** - The infrastructure linking Crumlin by bus, rail and road is abysmal. We have been pushing continually at the Assembly for the rail link to be reopened and for bus services to be extended to better link the town to Antrim and Belfast. I and my colleagues will never let this matter drop as I believe it is vital.

**Youth matters** - I have continually supported Crumlin Together and have written to Minister Foster, as well as Crumlin United and other organisations to help put it all in place. Crumlin needs more facilities for sport and leisure and with my colleagues I will keep pushing for all sports. I have tried to open up the facilities at Aldergrove, as well as pushed for St. Joseph's not to develop, and for other options. This battle will go on.

**Rose Energy** - It is essential we get this decision right for Northern Ireland, in particular for the farming industry, local industry such as Radox and for the local population. Other options exist, such as 'Energy from Waste' and must be explored and the facts need to be presented correctly by all sides. I will ensure that this is so and that no side is ignored.

Crumlin is very special to me and it needs everyone working together, helping each other and most importantly supporting the local community groups and local trade and commerce.
